Réamhrá

Tugann an doiciméad seo tuairisc ar thorthaí na féinmheastóireachta agus ár bplean feabhsúcháin, ina n-áirímid na spriocanna agus na gníomhaíochtaí tá i gceist againn a dhéanamh chun aidhmeanna an phlean a thabhairt i gcrích. Cruthaíodh an pleán feabhsúcháin seo chun síriú ar theagasc agus fhoghlaím na Gaeilge inár scoil. Tosaíodh ar eolas a bhailíú go neamhfhoirmeálta roimh 2022 agus go foirmeálta i rith an chéad téarma sa bláthain 2022.

Seo an chéad uair againn pleán feabhsúcháin scoile a dhéanamh ar Ghaeilge.

Fócas na meastóireachta seo.

Rinneamar féinmheastóireacht ar theagasc agus ar fhoghlaím i rith an tréimhse ó Mheán Fómhair 2022 go Márt 2023. Rinneamar meastóireacht ar na gnéithe seo a leanas den teagasc agus den fhoghlaím:

- Eispéiris na bhfoghlaimeoírí – Glacann na daltaí páirt i ngníomhaíochtaí foghlama bríochára bhealach a bhfuil cuspóir leis - Léiríonn na daltaí leibhéal an-ard suime agus rannpháirtíochta san fhoghlaím.
- Eispéiris na bhfoghlaimeoírí – Faigheann na daltaí deiseanna chun na scileanna agus na dearctaí atá riachtanach don fhoghlaím ar feadh an tsaoil a forbairt – Déanann daltaí naísc bhríochára agus iontaofa idir an fhoghlaím i réimsí agus ábhair éagsúla curaclaim agus úsáideann said na naísc seo chun a gcuid foghlama a threorú.
- Cleachtas aonair na múinteoirí – Roghnaíonn agus úsáideann an múinteoir cuir chuige teagaisc atá oiriúnach do na torthaí foghlama atá beartaithe agus do riachtanais foghlama na ndaltaí – Déanann múinteoirí scileanna litearthachta ábhartha a chomhtháthú sa cheacht.
- Cleachtas comhchoiteann/ comhoibríoch na múinteoirí - Oibríonn múinteoirí le chéile chun deiseanna foghlama a cheapadh do dhaltaí ar fud an churaclaim agus lasmuigh de – Comhphleanann múinteoirí eispéiris foghlama a chumasaíonn agus a chumhachaíonn daltaí féachaint ar an bhfoghlaím mar iarracht iomlánaíoch ar feadh an tsaoil.

Torthaí

Seo cleachtas éifeachtach/an-éifeachtach inár scoil

Liostaigh príomh láidreachtaí na scoile sa teagasc agus sa bhfoghlaím.

- Shíleamar go mbeadh titim i dtorthaí na scrúdaithe caighdeánacha Gaeilge de bharr Covid 19 ach ar an iomlán, lean na torthaí cuar Bell agus bhíomar sásta.
- Léirigh an tsuirbhé a rinne na múinteoirí go bhfuil 92% daoibh sásta bheith ag múineadh Gaeilge agus go mbraitheann 69% daoibh inniúil i múineadh na Gaeilge.
- Tá 82% de thuismitheoirí sásta le dul chun cinn a bpáiste sa Ghaeilge faoi láthair.
- Go ginearálta, léiríonn tuismitheoirí dearcadh dearfach i leith na Gaeilge agus braitheann 73% gur chuid tábháchtacht d'fhéiniúlacht a bpáiste an Ghaeilge.
- Léirigh suirbhé na ndaltaí go bhfuair 74% de na daltaí a líon an tsuirbhé Gaeilge ‘éasca’ (16%) nó ‘ok don chuid is mó’ (58%) rud a thaispeánann go bhfuil ceachtanna curtha in oiriúint dá gcumas.
- Thaispeáin an tsuirbhé gur cluichí (67%), scéalta (41%), agus amhráin (34%) na bealaí ba thaithneamháil le daltaí chun Gaeilge a fhoghlaím.

Seo mar is eol dúinn

Liostaigh foinsí fianaise, tagair do mheoin, gnóthachtáil, eolas agus scileanna na bpáistí.

- Léiríonn an anailís ghrinn bhliantúil ar thorthaí scrúdaithe caighdeánacha go bhfuil daltaí, den chuid is mó, ag baint a gcumas amach.
- Dáileadh suirbhéanna ar thuismitheoirí, ar dhaltaí agus ar mhúinteoirí.
- Rinneadh plé neamhfhoirméálta idir dhaltaí agus mhúinteoirí.

Díreoidim orthu seo a leanas chun feabhas breise a chur ar ár gcleachtas:

Sonraigh na gnéithe den teagasc agus den fhoghlaim atá aitheanta ag an scoil agus a bhfuil túis áite tugtha dóibh le feabhsúcháin breise a dhéanamh orthu.

- Tháinig aiseolas an-dearfach ar an iomlán ar Bhua na Cainte (seo an chéad bhliain inar úsáideadh an scéim i ngach rang) ach léiríonn aiseolas ó dhaltaí agus ó mhúinteoirí go bhfuil gá cur leis. Mheas múinteoirí go raibh gá le cur leis an gclár go speisialta ó thaobh léitheoireachta agus litriú de.
- Ní mór an ceangal idir baile agus scoil ó thaobh na Gaeilge a neartú. Ba mhaith le 50% de thuismitheoirí níos mó tacaíochta i leith na Gaeilge agus bhí 78% de thuismitheoirí aineolach ar leathanach faoi leith don Ghaeilge a bheith ar shuíomh idirlín na scoile.
- Mhothaigh múinteoirí gur chuir dearcadh na ndaltaí cosc suntasach lena bhfoghlaim agus nár léirigh ach 36% de dhaltaí gur mhaith nó gur bhreá leo an teanga.

1. Introduction

This document records the findings of this self-evaluation, and our current improvement plan, including targets and the actions we will implement to meet the targets. This improvement plan was created to focus on the teaching and learning of Gaeilge in our school. Data collection began informally before 2022 and formally in Term 1 of 2022.

1.1 Outcomes of our last improvement plan from [date] to [date]

- This is the first time we have conducted formal SSE on Gaeilge.

1.2 The focus of this evaluation

We undertook self-evaluation of teaching and learning during the period *September 2022 – March 2023*. We evaluated the following aspect(s) of teaching and learning:

- Learner experiences – Children engage purposefully in meaningful learning activities – children demonstrate very high levels of interest and participation in learning.
- Teachers' collective / collaborative practice -Teachers select and use teaching approaches appropriate to learning outcomes and to pupils' learning needs – Teachers integrate relevant literacy skills into the lessons.
- Teachers' collective / collaborative practice -Teachers work together to devise learning opportunities for pupils across and beyond the curriculum – Teachers collaboratively plan learning experiences that enable and empower pupils to see learning as a holistic and lifelong endeavour.
- Learner experiences – Children experience opportunities to develop the skills and attitudes necessary for lifelong learning – children make meaningful and authentic connections between school-based learning and learning that takes place in other contexts.

2. Findings

2.1 This is effective / very effective practice in our school

List the main strengths of the school in teaching and learning.

- We expected to see a dip in standardised results in Gaeilge following Covid 19 but were pleased with healthy results overall, which generally followed the bell curve.
- From the teachers' survey, 92% of teachers enjoy teaching Irish and 69% of teachers feel confident teaching Irish.
- 82% of parents are happy with their child's current progress in Gaeilge.
- Generally parents have a positive attitude towards Gaeilge with 73% feeling that Gaeilge is an important part of their child's identity.
- The student survey highlighted that 74% of students surveyed found Gaeilge either 'easy' (16%) or 'mostly okay' (58%) indicating that lessons are appropriately pitched.
- Games (67%), stories (41%) and songs (34%) were identified in the student survey as 'favourite ways to learn Irish'.

2.2. This is how we know

- Careful annual analysis of standardised test results show that students are, in the main, reaching potential.
- Surveys were distributed to parents, students and teachers.
- Informal discussions took place with students and teachers.

2.3 This is what we are going to focus on to improve our practice further

- The feedback on Bua na Cainte (this year is the first year that it is being implemented in every class) overall was very positive but feedback from students and teachers indicate a need to supplement it. Léitheoiréachta and spelling especially were areas where teachers felt a strong need to supplement the programme.
- Home-school Gaeilge links need to be strengthened. Nearly 50% of parents would like more support in the area of Gaeilge and 78% of parents did not know that the school had a dedicated page on the website for Gaeilge.
- Teachers felt that the children's attitude to the language was a key barrier to learning and only 36% of students reported that they like or love the language.
